

## Ça Va Bien Aller

*32 bar reel for three couples in a longwise set*

- 1 - 4      1st couple cross giving a right hand and cast down one place as the 2nd couple step up on 3&4 2,(1),3
- 5 - 16      2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance a variation of Rights and Lefts for three couples): **(dancers in second corner position set instead of changing left hands on the diagonal)\*** All three couples cross giving a right hand; 2nd man and 3rd woman set while 2nd woman and 1st man/3rd man and 1st woman change places left hand on the sides. All three couples cross giving a right hand; 1st woman and 1st man set while 2nd man and 3rd man/2nd woman and 3rd woman change places left hand on the sides. All three couples cross giving a right hand: 3rd man and 2nd woman set while 1st man and 3rd woman/2nd man and 1st woman change places left hand on the sides to finish (3),1,(2)
- 17 - 24      1st couple dance two ½ reels of three across, giving left shoulder to their 1st corner to start, passing left shoulder through the middle and giving left shoulder to their 3rd corner position to finish in second place on own side. 2nd and 3rd couples dance two ½ left shoulder reels across.
- 25 - 32      1st couple dance diagonal rights and lefts twice; lady up, man down both times 2,1,3

Repeat having passed a couple.

\*I discovered this variation of R&Ls for three couples in the dance Millennium Wedding by Alan Cottle and Lesley McKenna. Fun variation to dance.
