

Paying for Classes:

The preferred method of payment for classes is by BACS payment to the Weymouth Scottish Country Dancers Bank Account, details below. The cost of classes will continue to be £3 per session. Paying by BACS will help to reduce bank charges. Since January 2025, Lloyds bank has been charging the club a monthly account maintenance fee together with fees associated with handling cash and cheques. We have 100 free BACS transactions per month so it makes sense to use this method for transactions in and out of the account.

We will need a small amount of cash for sundry items such as milk, biscuits, etc. so anyone unable to use BACS will still be able to pay with cash.

Ideally dancers will pay an amount (in multiples of £3) via BACS to create a number of prepaid credits. Each time you come to class your credit total will be reduced by 1. You will not lose any credits if you miss a class. The credits will be maintained on an individual basis. Credits must be paid at least 2-days before the first class they are to be used. Any number of credits can be purchased at a time, you could pay monthly, every 5 weeks, etc. it is up to you. Please do not pay weekly! Credits can be used for both Thursday evening dance sessions and the Friday Challenge sessions.
